Sub: Notice regarding Common Entrance Test (CET) for Non-AICTE courses, JEMAT for MBA and MHA and Post Graduate Entrance Test (PGET) for M.Tech and M.Pharm of 2022-23.

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform you that the organizing committee meeting was held on 18/07/2022 with the members offering Non-AICTE, MBA, MHA, M.Tech and M.Pharm courses under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to finalize the Entrance Exam Dates of CET-II and JEMAT-II and promotional programmes of the University.

After discussion with the members:-

Resolved that MAKAUT, WB will conduct CET-II exam on 30th August, 2022 (Tuesday) JEMAT-II on 31st August (Wednesday)

It was resolved that the examination would be conducted through online mode.

It was resolved further that for CET, examinations will be conducted into two batches, 03:00 PM for UG and 05:00 PM for PG.

Online Examination forms will be available from the dedicated portal on and from 25th July, 2022. Students willing to participate in the Entrance Examination will have to fill up the forms with choices of colleges and courses in the portal. After publication of respective Board/Council/ University results, the student has to take final admission within 7 days to the respective colleges/Institutes where they would get allotment as per their choice after publication of CET-II and JEMAT-II results.

MAKAUT-WB will make awareness campaign for the benefit of the students highlighting all courses, curriculum and the facilities of the Colleges/ Institutions through the digital media, newspaper advertisement, Television Talk Show, campaign in Electronic media which will start from 25th July, 2022 for showcasing the courses run by University and its affiliated colleges.

In case of M.Tech and M.Pharm courses no second Post Graduate Entrance Test (PGET) will be held by the University. Colleges running M.Tech and M.Pharm courses are hereby requested to take students after completion of first PGET admission following due procedure like admission notification, merit based selection as per admission criteria and publication of merit list with detailed intimation to the University.
